Wright-Patt Credit Union (WPCU®) is a proud participant of CO-OP Shared Branching! As a WPCU member, Shared Branching gives you the ability to do a range of transactions at any one of the more than 5,600 participating credit unions across the nation.

What is Shared Branching?

Shared Branching is a network of credit unions across the country that actually "share" branches. If you are a member of a participating credit union, you can bank at any branch within the network. These branches are identified by the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo.

Where are Shared Branches?

Shared Branches are where YOU are! Thousands of Shared Branches are located across the United States as well as Ecuador, Germany, Italy, Japan, Korea, and Puerto Rico. There is no need to worry if college, business, or a weekend getaway has taken you away from your home credit union location. No matter the reason, you can make real-time transactions at any participating branch.

There is almost always a Shared Branching location nearby. Just look for the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo.

How to locate a shared branch

WPCU is here to help you locate a Shared Branching location anytime, anywhere. Check out the locator search on your WPCU Mobile App or by visiting our website at WPCU.coop/Locations.

How does it work?

Simply stop in any credit union that displays the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo. When performing a transaction at a Shared Branch, remember to provide the following:

- Your home credit union's name
- Your account number
- A valid government-issued photo I.D., such as a state driver's license or U.S. passport

Is it secure?

Yes. Using a Shared Branch is just as safe and secure as using your home credit union.

What transactions can I conduct?

You can conduct the following transactions at any Shared Branch:

- Cash/Check deposits
- Cash/Check withdrawals, up to \$3,500 per day.
- Loan payments
- Transfer between accounts
- Statement printouts
- Purchase money orders*
- Purchase official checks*

Shared Branching is a free member service provided by WPCU.
