

UNLAWFUL INTERNET GAMBLING ENFORCEMENT ACT OF 2006 DISCLOSURE

Notice to Wright-Patt Credit Union Business Members Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006

This notice is provided in accordance with the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 (UIGEA) and Regulation GG.

The UIGEA prohibits any person engaged in the business of betting or wagering from knowingly accepting payments in connection with the participation of another person in unlawful internet gambling. As defined by Regulation GG, unlawful internet gambling means — "to place, receive, or otherwise knowingly transmit a bet or wager by any means which involves the use, at least in part, of the internet where such bet or wager is unlawful under any applicable Federal or State law in the State or Tribal lands in which the bet or wager is initiated, received, or otherwise made."

As a business member of Wright-Patt Credit Union, Inc. (WPCU), these restricted transactions are prohibited from being processed through your account or credit union relationship with WPCU. WPCU reserves the right to close your account if you engage in an internet gambling business, as well as block or reject any suspected restricted transaction(s).
